

## Hold Fast to Jesus Review

Lessons 1-20

Hebrews 1-7

End of lesson 20 - Last verse we read together was

Heb 8:1 NOW THIS IS THE MAIN POINT OF THE THINGS WE ARE SAYING:

WE HAVE SUCH A HIGH PRIEST,  
WHO IS SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND  
OF THE THRONE OF THE MAJESTY IN THE HEAVENS!

\*Read this again to begin the review

Let's look back at what has been said up until now to get to this point...

\***Lessons 1-2** The Introduction and Jesus Christ -the Son of God (Heb 1:1-4)

On **pg 16** go through the 7 descriptions of Jesus from Heb. *Go around the table should be quick, no need to go through the cross references. This is to be a reminder of where we started*

\***Lessons 3-4** The Exalted Jesus and the Dominion of Jesus our Lord and Savior (Heb 1:5-14)

On **pg 20** we broke the passage up into 7 sections based on cross references. At the bottom of pg 21 we were to write the characteristic of Jesus next to the verse (or section) *Note those descriptions. This should stay focused on Jesus and who He is. It should also be a quick review. If it is confusing please feel free to move on to pg 25.*

On **pg 25** (1/3 the way down) **ask**: In our description of Jesus we have not yet noted that He is anointed King. How does Heb 1:8-9 describe His reign?

\***Lesson 5** The First Warning (Heb 2:1-4)

Near the top of **page 29 go over this questions**: The basic warning given in Hebrews 2:1. Note 2 aspects- what to do and what not to do.

*Lesson 6 was an overview...*

**\*Lesson 7** Jesus - Son of Man (Heb 2:5-9)

Bottom of **Pg 39** ask : What is shown to be of great importance in Hebrews 2:9?  
What brought about the crowning glory?

**\* Lesson 8** Jesus Christ - Made Like Us (Heb 2:10-18)

On **pg 43** (under box) ask : What did Jesus do that made Him a trailblazer, according to Hebrews 2:10-18? *Let a few answer. Do not need to spend lots of time on this- just want this to be a review*

**\*Lesson 9** The Greatest of All Time (Heb 3:1-6)

On **pg 46** (at bottom) ask: What two roles were given to Jesus and how did he receive them?

On **pg 50** (middle of page) ask: What were the two instructions given in vs 3:1 and 3:6

**\*Lesson 10** Beware of Unbelief: The Second Warning (Heb 3:7-19)

On **Pg 53** ask: in Heb 3:12-13 What is the pastor's warning? What is the pastor's instruction?

**\*Lesson 11** A Sabbath Celebration (Heb 4:1-11)

*Remember* (pg 57 at bottom) The second warning leads into this passage on rest. Heb 3:7-4:13 is a complete unit. *This is a reminder. Feel free to read this to you ladies.*

On **pg 59** Ask :Looking at Heb 4:3, what do we see that belief (faith) gives us?

On **pg 60** (  $\frac{1}{3}$  down the pg) ask: What very good news is stated in Heb 4:9?

*These two questions go together...pointing out that we who believe are able to enter that rest and that there remains a sabbath rest for the people of God. Great reminder after the warning of unbelief in 3:12.*

**\*Lesson 12** God has Spoken (Heb 4:12-13)

On **pg 62** (at the bottom) List the truth from Heb 4:12 (5)

On **pg 63** (at the top) ask: What is the situation for every person on earth, according to Heb 4:13 (3) *Go around the table. No need to go through cross references. This is another reminder to pay attention to what God has said.*

**\*Lesson 13** An Intriguing Introduction (*Into Jesus as High Priest*) (Heb 4:14-16)

On **pg 66** (at bottom) ask :What details are we given about Jesus in verses 14 and 15? *Go around table. Again, don't spend much time on these-just review.*

**\*Lesson 14** What We All Need (Heb 5:1-11)

On **bottom of pg 72 and top of pg 73** read through your notes on how Jesus became High Priest, His role, His weakness, and how He empathizes with others. *This is to be a lead in to the next question and refresh the ladies memories about Jesus as our Great High Priest.*

Then on **pg 74** (middle of Pg) ask : Consider the actions of Jesus as our High Priest. Why is it important to understand Jesus role as High Priest?

**\*Lesson 15** On to Maturity: The Third Warning (Heb 5:11-6:12)

\*\*\*This is a more INTENSE WARNING\*\*\*

On **pg 75** (at bottom) ask what is the main problem pointed out by the pastor? He repeats it in Heb 5:11 and 6:12.

On **pg 78** (1/3 down the pg) ask : according to Heb 6:1-2, what two actions did they have to take to cooperate with God's work in their lives?

**\*Lessons 16 and 17** A Very Sober Warning and A Lot To Think About (Heb 6:4-12)

*Here we looked at a warning of consequences and then worked through its interpretations/meaning*

On **pg 82** ( 2/3 down) ask : Review the warning in Hebrews 6:4-6. What is the problem and the consequence?

On **pg 82** ( bottom) ask : what illustration is given in Heb 6:7-8 as an example of right and wrong behavior and the reward and punishment for them.

**\*Lesson 18** Trust the promises of God (Heb 6:13-20)

*Abraham given as a powerful example to the readers to show diligence for the final realization of their hope (pg92)*

On **pg 93** (in the box) Read: two unchangeable things a) the promise of God and b) the oath by which His promise is confirmed THEN ask (the next question) :What us the result of this promised promise of God? What do we have according to Heb 6:18-20?

**\*Lesson 19** Mysterious Melchizedek (Heb 7:1-24)

On pg 96 (at bottom) ask: How would you describe “the order of Melchizedek” and what this tells us about Jesus as High Priest? *Remember to keep this brief.*

**\*Lesson 20** Our Personal Perfect High Priest (Heb 7:25-28)

On **pg 100** (middle) ask : Why can Jesus Stand before the throne of God, according to Heb 7:26-27?

*This leads back to **Pg 102** Reread Heb 8:1*

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
