*Psalm 91*

**I. Speak the Truth – Ps 91: 1-2**

<sup>NAS</sup> **Psalm 91:1** He who dwells in the <sup>a</sup>shelter of the Most High Will abide in the <sup>b</sup>shadow of the Almighty.

<sup>2</sup> I will say to the LORD, "My <sup>a</sup>refuge and my <sup>b</sup>fortress, My God, in whom I <sup>c</sup>trust!"

**II. Fear No Trials – Ps 91: 3-12**

<sup>3</sup> For it is He who delivers you from the <sup>a</sup>snare of the trapper, And from the deadly <sup>b</sup>pestilence.

<sup>4</sup> He will <sup>a</sup>cover you with His pinions, And <sup>b</sup>under His wings you may seek refuge; His <sup>c</sup>faithfulness is a <sup>d</sup>shield and bulwark.

<sup>5</sup> You <sup>a</sup>will not be afraid of the <sup>b</sup>terror by night, Or of the <sup>c</sup>arrow that flies by day;

<sup>6</sup> Of the <sup>a</sup>pestilence that <sup>1</sup>stalks in darkness, Or of the <sup>b</sup>destruction that lays waste at noon. <sup>7</sup> A thousand may fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; But <sup>a</sup>it shall not approach you.

<sup>8</sup> You will only look on with your eyes, And <sup>a</sup>see the recompense of the wicked.

<sup>9</sup> <sup>1</sup>For you have made the LORD, <sup>a</sup>my refuge, Even the Most High, <sup>b</sup>your dwelling place. <sup>10</sup> <sup>a</sup>No evil will befall you, Nor will any plague come near your <sup>1</sup>tent.

<sup>11</sup> For He will give <sup>a</sup>His angels charge concerning you, To guard you in all your ways.

<sup>12</sup> They will <sup>a</sup>bear you up in their hands, Lest you strike your foot against a stone.

**III. Look for Triumph – Ps 91:13-16**

<sup>13</sup> You will <sup>a</sup>tread upon the lion and cobra, The young lion and the <sup>1</sup>serpent you will trample down.

<sup>14</sup> <sup>a</sup>"Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him; I will <sup>b</sup>set him securely on high, because he has <sup>c</sup>known My name.

<sup>15</sup> "He will <sup>a</sup>call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in <sup>1</sup>trouble; I will rescue him, and <sup>b</sup>honor him.

<sup>16</sup> "With <sup>1</sup>a <sup>a</sup>long life I will satisfy him, And <sup>2</sup><sup>b</sup>let him behold My salvation."
