

Corresponding sequence between Creation account in Genesis and Psalm 104

Day 1: Earth, Space, Time And Light

Ps 104:2 Who cover Yourself with light as with a garment, Who stretch out the heavens like a curtain.

Genesis 1:3 ³ Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light

Day 2: Atmosphere

Psalm 104:3 He lays the beams of His upper chambers in the waters, Who makes the clouds His chariot, Who walks on the wings of the wind,

Genesis 1:6-8 ⁶ Then God said, "Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters." ⁸ And God called the firmament Heaven. So the evening and the morning were the second day.

Day 3: Dry Land And Plants

Psalm 104:14 ¹⁴ He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, And vegetation for the service of man, That he may bring forth food from the earth,

Genesis 1:9-13 ⁹ Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear"; and it was so. ^{verse 11} Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth"; and it was so.

Day 4: Sun, Moon, Stars

Psalm 104:19 ¹⁹ He appointed the moon for seasons; The sun knows its going down

Genesis 1:14-19 ¹⁴ Then God said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; ¹⁵ "and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so. ¹⁶ Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. Day 5: Fish And Birds And Sea Monsters

Psalm 104:25-26 This great and wide sea, In which are innumerable teeming things, Living things both small and great, ²⁶ There the ships sail about; There is that Leviathan Which You have made to play there.

Genesis 1:20-22 ²⁰ Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens." ²¹ So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. ²² And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth."

Day 6: Land Animals And Man

Psalm 104:29-30 ²⁹ You hide Your face, they are troubled; You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust. ³⁰ You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth.

Genesis 1:24-27 ²⁴ Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind"; and it was so. ²⁶ Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness..... ²⁷ So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. **Genesis 2:7** ⁷ And the LORD God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being.

Corresponding Truths between Job and Psalm 104

1. **Psalm 104:5** You who laid the foundations of the earth, So that it should not be moved forever,
Job 38:4 " Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell Me, if you have understanding. ⁵ Who determined its measurements? Surely you know! Or who stretched the line upon it? ⁶ To what were its foundations fastened? Or who laid its cornerstone,
2. **Psalm 104:9** You have set a boundary that they may not pass over, That they may not return to cover the earth.
Job 38:10-11 ¹⁰ When I fixed My limit for it, And set bars and doors; ¹¹ When I said, "This far you may come, but no farther, And here your proud waves must stop!"
3. **Psalm 104:11-14** ¹¹ They give drink to every beast of the field; The wild donkeys quench their thirst. ¹² By them the birds of the heavens have their home; They sing among the branches. ¹³ He waters the hills from His upper chambers; The earth is satisfied with the fruit of Your works. ¹⁴ He causes the grass to grow for the cattle
Job 39:5 "Who set the wild donkey free? Who loosed the bonds of the onager, ⁶ Whose home I have made the wilderness, And the barren land his dwelling? ⁷ He scorns the tumult of the city; He does not heed the shouts of the driver. ⁸ The range of the mountains is his pasture, And he searches after every green thing
4. **Psalm 104:13** He waters the hills from His upper chambers; The earth is satisfied with the fruit of Your work
Job 38:25 "Who has divided a channel for the overflowing water, Or a path for the thunderbolt, ²⁶ To cause it to rain on a land where there is no one, A wilderness in which there is no man; ²⁷ To satisfy the desolate waste, And cause to spring forth the growth of tender grass? ²⁸ Has the rain a father? Or who has begotten the drops of dew? **Job 38:37** Who can number the clouds in wisdom? or who can stay the bottles of heaven,
5. **Psalm 104:14** He causes the grass to grow for the cattle, And vegetation for the service of man, That he may bring forth food from the earth,
Job 28:5 As for the earth, from it comes bread, But underneath it is turned up as by fire;
6. **Psalm 104:18** The high hills are for the wild goats; The cliffs are a refuge for the rock badgers.
Job 39:1 "Do you know the time when the wild mountain goats bear young? Or can you mark when the deer gives birth?
7. **Psalm 104:19** He appointed the moon for seasons; The sun knows its going down.
Job 38:12 " Have you commanded the morning since your days began, And caused the dawn to know its place,
8. **Psalm 104:21** The young lions roar after their prey, And seek their food from God.
Job 38:39 " Can you hunt the prey for the lion, Or satisfy the appetite of the young lions, ^{NKJ} **Job 38:41** Who provides food for the raven, When its young ones cry to God, And wander about for lack of food?
9. **Psalm 104:24** How countless are Your works, LORD! In wisdom You have made them all; the earth is full of Your creatures. ¹
Job 5:9 Who does great things, and unsearchable, Marvelous things without number.
10. **Psalm 104:26** There the ships sail about; There is that Leviathan Which You have made to play there.
Job 41:1-5 "Can you draw out Leviathan with a hook, Or snare his tongue with a line which you lower? ² Can you put a reed through his nose, Or pierce his jaw with a hook? ³ Will he make many supplications to you? Will he speak softly to you? ⁴ Will he make a covenant with you? Will you take him as a servant forever? ⁵ Will you play with him as with a bird, Or will you leash him for your maidens?
11. **Psalm 104:29** You hide Your face, they are troubled; You take away their breath, they die and return to their dust.
Job 34:14 If He should set His heart on it, If He should gather to Himself His Spirit and His breath, ¹⁵ All flesh would perish together, And man would return to dust.
12. **Psalm 104:30** You send forth Your Spirit, they are created; And You renew the face of the earth.
Job 33:4 The Spirit of God has made me, And the breath of the Almighty gives me life.
