Isaiah 65:18-19 ¹⁸ But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; For behold, I create Jerusalem *as* a rejoicing, And her people a joy. ¹⁹ I will rejoice in Jerusalem, And joy in My people;

Zephaniah 3:16-17 ¹⁶ In that day it shall be said to Jerusalem: "Do not fear; Zion, let not your hands be weak. ¹⁷ The LORD your God in your midst, The Mighty One, will save; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet *you* with His love, He will rejoice over you with singing."

2. God is glorified today when we rejoice in His plans, and our praise to Him will be multiplied when we see how He fulfills them.

 - a. Jews
 - a. 144, 000 sealed
 - b. Jews saved by 144, 000
 - c. Jews rescued by the Jesus the Breaker

b. Gentiles

a. Saved during Tribulation

(The sheep who ministered to Jews – Jesus' brothers
Matthew 25:37-40)

THE PEOPLE:

2. Mortals – (Jews and Gentiles = Israel and Nations)
 - a. First citizens: believers, filled with Holy Spirit,
still have sin nature
 - b. Babies born, sin nature, must accept Jesus as Savior by faith
 - c. Can still sin

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

THE PEOPLE:

3. Life and death

a.No infant mortality

b.Everyone lives to at least 100 years old

c.Only sinners die, starting at 100 yrs

Isaiah 65:20 ²⁰ No more shall there be in it an infant who lives but a few days, or an old man who does not fill out his days, for the young man shall die a hundred years old, and the sinner a hundred years old shall be accursed.

JUSTICE AND MERCY – THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

THE PEOPLE:

3. Life and death - Fruchtenbaum: “Death in the Messianic Kingdom is for unbelievers only, those born in the Messianic Kingdom have until their 100th birthday to believe, if they don’t believe they will die.”

d. No mention anywhere in Scripture of a resurrection of Millennial Kingdom saints

e. No Jewish unbelievers – all will accept Messiah as Savior by 100th birthday (Jeremiah 31: 31-34)

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, ...³³ But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more."

Micah 4:1-4 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; and peoples shall flow to it. ²Many nations shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, and we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion the law shall go forth, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem..

The Mountain of the House of the Lord

3. 50 x 50 mile – square plateau, 3 sections. Eze 45:1-8

a. NORTHERN SECTION:

The temple – 1 square mile

Living quarters for Priests, Levites –descendants of Zadok

b. CENTRAL SECTION - reserved for tribe of Levi

3. 50 x 50 mile – square plateau, 3 sections. Eze 45:1-8

c. SOUTHERN SECTION

50 x 10 miles

Millennial Jerusalem – 10 x 10 miles

Fields for crops on each side of the city **Ezekiel 48:18-19**

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

The Mountain of the House of the Lord

Ezekiel 48:18-19 ¹⁸ Outside the city there will be a farming area that stretches 3-1/3 miles to the east and 3-1/3 miles to the west along the border of the sacred area. This farmland will produce food for the people working in the city. ¹⁹ Those who come from the various tribes to work in the city may farm it.

Jerusalem:

a. The Glorious City! The Center of the World!

Isaiah 65:17-19 ¹⁷ "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth, and the former things shall not be remembered or come into mind. ¹⁸ But be glad and rejoice forever in that which I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem to be a joy, and her people to be a gladness. ¹⁹ I will rejoice in Jerusalem and be glad in my people; no more shall be heard in it the sound of weeping and the cry of distress.

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

Jerusalem:

b. Building projects

Exodus 31:3-5 ³ I have filled him with the Spirit of God, giving him great wisdom, ability, and expertise in all kinds of crafts. ⁴ He is a master craftsman, expert in working with gold, silver, and bronze. ⁵ He is skilled in engraving and mounting gemstones and in carving wood. He is a master at every craft!

Jerusalem:

- c. Host to the nations
- d. Name of the city - YHWH SHAMMAH - The LORD IS THERE Eze 48:35
- e. Shekinah glory of God – visible manifestation of His presence -
Cloud, smoke, and fire

Jerusalem:

Isaiah 4:2-6 On that day the branch of the LORD will be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the land will be the pride and glory of Israel's survivors. ³Whoever remains in Zion and whoever is left in Jerusalem will be called holy- all in Jerusalem who are destined to live- ⁴when the Lord has washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion and cleansed the bloodguilt from the heart of Jerusalem by a spirit of judgment and a spirit of burning

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

Jerusalem:

Isaiah 4:2-6 Then the LORD will create a cloud of smoke by day and a glowing flame of fire by night over the entire site of Mount Zion and over its assemblies. For there will be a canopy over all the glory, ⁶and there will be a booth for shade from heat by day, and a refuge and shelter from storm and rain.

^{CSB} **1 Kings 4:25** Throughout Solomon's *reign*, Judah and Israel lived in safety from Dan to Beer-sheba, each man under his own vine and his own fig tree.

PROSPERITY

Sennacherib of Assyria:

2 Kings 18:30-32 ³⁰ Do not let Hezekiah make you trust in the LORD by saying, 'The LORD will surely deliver us, and this city will not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria.' ³¹ Do not listen to Hezekiah, for thus says the king of Assyria: 'Make your peace with me and come out to me. Then each one of you will eat of his own vine, and each one of his own fig tree...

PROSPERITY

Micah 4:4 but they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree, and no one shall make them afraid, for the mouth of the LORD of hosts has spoken.

Zechariah 3:10 On that day, each of you will invite his neighbor to sit under his vine and fig tree.” This is the declaration of the LORD of Hosts.

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

PROSPERITY

Isaiah 65:21-24 They shall build houses and inhabit them; they shall plant vineyards and eat their fruit. ²² They shall not build and another inhabit; they shall not plant and another eat; for like the days of a tree shall the days of my people be, and my chosen shall long enjoy the work of their hands. ²³ They shall not labor in vain or bear children for calamity, for they shall be the offspring of the blessed of the LORD, and their descendants with them. ²⁴ Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear.

JUSTICE AND MERCY — THE MESSIANIC KINGDOM

PROSPERITY

- a. Enjoyment of work and production
- b. No land disputes. No fear of crime or war.
- c. Absence of calamity and turmoil
- d. Quick answers from God, before they even ask
- e. Peace among animals

Psalms 72:16 May there be abundance of grain in the land; on the tops of the mountains may it wave; may its fruit be like Lebanon; and may people blossom in the cities like the grass of the field!

Psalms 92:12 The righteous thrive like a palm tree and grow like a cedar tree in Lebanon. ¹³ Planted in the house of the LORD, they thrive in the courtyards of our God. ¹⁴ They will still bear fruit in old age, healthy and green

Isaiah 35:1 The wilderness and the dry land will be glad; the desert will rejoice and blossom like a rose.

The Nation of ISRAEL

a. Reunited as one nation, of all 12 tribes

Ezekiel 37:21-22 ²¹ "Then say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Surely I will take the children of Israel from among the nations, wherever they have gone, and will gather them from every side and bring them into their own land; ²² "and I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel; and one king shall be king over them all; they shall no longer be two nations, nor shall they ever be divided into two kingdoms again.

The Nation of ISRAEL

b. Center of Gentile attention

Zephaniah 3:20 At that time I will bring you back, Even at the time I gather you; For I will give you fame and praise Among all the peoples of the earth, When I return your captives before your eyes," Says the LORD.

JESUS WILL REIGN as King of Israel and King of all the nations

The government

a. Jesus – the king on the throne of David

- doing justice
- reigning with rod of iron
- innocent receive justice
- guilty are punished
- all rulers subject themselves to His authority
- men bless Him, He blesses men

JESUS WILL REIGN as King of Israel and King of all the nations

The government

b. Gentile branch of government

- Resurrected, glorified saints (from church age) reign.
- Mortals reign as kings over nations under authority of saints and Jesus

The government

c. Jewish branch of government – includes:

1. resurrected David - king over Israel, prince under Jesus
2. resurrected 12 apostles reign over the 12 tribes of Israel

c. Jewish branch of government – includes:

3. Israelites in authority: **Isaiah 32:1** Behold, a king will reign in righteousness, And princes will rule with justice.

4. resurrected Zerubbabel **Haggai 2:23** “In that day,” says the LORD of hosts, “I will take you, Zerubbabel My servant, the son of Shealtiel,” says the LORD, “and will make you like a signet ring; for I have chosen you,” says the LORD of hosts.
