## THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF THE DEATH OF THE MESSIAH

1. Jesus' death made \_\_\_\_\_ for our sins. John 3:14-16

Atonement (OT) / Propitiation (NT) – Greek – ἱλαστήριος - satisfied, turned away the wrath of God

2. Jesus' death \_\_\_\_\_ us to God. Romans 5:10 - changed from enemies to friends

4. The Demands of God's \_\_\_\_\_ were met. Romans 8:1-2

5. Removal of \_\_\_\_\_ Sins Hebrews 10:4; Romans 3:25

"When He forgave us "all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands," setting it aside by nailing it to the cross," He removed the ground of Satan's \_\_\_\_\_ against us. *Biblical Doctrine*

**Around 1000 BC:** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Psalm 22:16** For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet.

*Pierce – Greek: orusso*

**Around 750 BC:** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Isaiah 53:8** He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

*Cut off–*

**Around 500 BC:** <sup>NKJ</sup> **Zechariah 12:10** And I will pour on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the Spirit of grace and supplication; then they will look on Me whom they pierced.

*Pierced – Hebrew: daqar –*

**John 19:34-37; Psalm 34:19-20**

## THE REALITY OF THE DEATH OF THE MESSIAH

Jesus' 7 Statements from the Cross:

- 1<sup>st</sup> - "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do."
- 2<sup>nd</sup> - "Today thou shalt be with me in Paradise."
- 3<sup>rd</sup> - "Behold thy mother. Woman behold thy son."
- 4<sup>th</sup> - "My God, My God, why has Thou forsaken Me?"
- 5<sup>th</sup> - "I thirst."
- 6<sup>th</sup> - "It is finished."
- 7<sup>th</sup> - "Father! Into Thy hands I commit my spirit."

<sup>ESV</sup> **John 12:24** Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit.
